Insurance Requirement & Prohibited Items Policy

Renter's Insurance

As a condition of continued occupancy in a public housing unit managed by the Housing Authority, residents are strongly encouraged to obtain and maintain renter's insurance for the duration of their tenancy. While renter's insurance is not required by federal regulation, it is highly recommended to protect the resident's personal belongings and provide liability coverage.

The Housing Authority is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of personal property belonging to the resident or members of the household.

Prohibited Items

To ensure the safety of residents and to comply with liability and risk management standards, the following items are strictly prohibited on or around Housing Authority property:

- Swimming pools of any kind, including inflatable or temporary pools
- Trampolines
- Swings or swing sets
- Inflatable recreational structures (e.g., bounce houses, moonwalks, and similar equipment)

Enforcement

The presence or use of any of the above-listed items on Housing Authority property constitutes a violation of the lease agreement and may result in lease enforcement action, up to and including termination of tenancy.
