Vehicle & Parking Policy

Safe Communities • Safe Parking • Resident Responsibility

Purpose

This policy helps keep Housing Authority neighborhoods safe, clean, attractive, and accessible. Compliance is a condition of residency.

Resident Responsibilities

Residents are responsible for their own vehicles and those of household members and guests.

Vehicle Requirements

- Current license plates and registration
- Operable and safely maintained
- Comply with Louisiana law

Parking Rules

- Park only in designated parking areas.
- Do not park on grass, sidewalks, fire lanes, near hydrants, dumpsters, or entrances.
- Do not block emergency access.

Abandoned Vehicles

Vehicles that are unlicensed, inoperable, left on blocks, missing major parts, or unmoved for more than 14 consecutive days may be towed.

Vehicle Repairs

Only minor emergency repairs needed to move a vehicle are allowed. Major repairs are prohibited.

Parking on Grass

A \$25 charge may be assessed for each occurrence.

Enforcement

Violations may result in warnings, charges, towing, lease violations, or other remedies allowed under the lease and HUD regulations.
