Utility Requirement Policy

Keeping Every Home Safe, Livable, and Code-Compliant

Requirement

As a condition of occupancy in a public housing unit managed by the Housing Authority of the City of Bunkie, all essential utility services — gas, water, and electricity — must be connected and active at all times during the term of the lease.

Residents are required to make all necessary arrangements to have these utilities turned on immediately upon lease execution and prior to moving into the unit. Failure to do so constitutes noncompliance with basic habitability standards as defined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Noncompliance

In accordance with HUD regulations, any resident who fails to establish and maintain required utility services may be subject to lease termination and eviction.

If utilities are not connected and maintained, the Housing Authority may issue a written 10-day notice to cure the violation. If the issue is not resolved within the specified timeframe, eviction proceedings will be initiated.
